

Keller Chiropractic Financial Policy

Full payment is expected the day of service. Payment can be by check, cash or credit card (Discover, MasterCard, or Visa).

Effective January 1, 2008 Keller Chiropractic has withdrawn from all insurance networks except Medicare and Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation. Unless you are a Medicare or BWC patient you will be responsible to pay on the day of service. You can check with your insurance to see if they will reimburse you for out of network services. We will provide you with a receipt that has the information that most insurance companies require. If your insurance requires a special form, we can provide the CMS-1500 form, but there will be a processing fee.

Doctor Keller is certified by Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation to treat injured workers. Approval must be obtained before care can commence.

If your injuries are the result of an automobile accident, please note **we do not take assignment** for personal injury claims. Therefore you will be required to pay at the time of service. We will give you a receipt, which you can send to the insurance company.

Dr. Keller is a participating provider for Medicare. Please read and sign separate Medicare policy.

Vitamins, supplements, educational books, equipment, supports and braces are a separate charge and will need to be paid on the day of service.

COMMON CHARGES:

NEW PATIENT VISIT \$89.00

Up 60 minutes for new patient evaluation, treatment, therapy, and teaching.

STANDARD VISIT \$39.00

Up to 15 minutes, and may include manipulation, therapy, and/or teaching.

EXTENDED VISIT \$60.00

Up to 30 minutes for complex or new condition, may include exam, manipulation, therapy, and/or teaching.

IN-DEPTH VISIT \$120.00

One hour for extended chiropractic work and /or lifestyle counseling.

MAINTENANCE / PREVENTATIVE PREPAID VISITS \$198 FOR 6. (\$33 per visit)

Up to 15 minutes for a stable condition, and may include manipulation, therapy, and/or teaching.

MEDICARE

We do bill Medicare but Medicare has special rules for chiropractic care. Medicare does NOT pay 100% of charges for chiropractic care. You WILL have some out-of-pocket expense. Please contact our office for details and a copy of our Medicare Policy.

WORKERS COMPENSATION

Charges for pre-approved workers compensation care are paid by the state Bureau of Workers Compensation. If we accept your case and if it is approved by the BWC you should not have any out of pocket expenses. If care is provided without approval you will be responsible for non-paid charges.
